Minutes

Philip Fowler made a motion to approve the June 24, 2019 Town Council Minutes as presented, Loren Moore second the motion, all were in favor.

Planning/BZA

Brough submitted a letter to the Council Members explaining why she felt the need to hire another clerical person to cover during absences of town office staff; while maintaining the normal office hours of 8 to 4, Monday through Friday. Marley said he thought it would be good. After much discussion, it was decided the Clerk Treasurer would include the position in the 2020 budget for the Council Member's review on July 22, 2019.

2020 Budget

Loren Moore made a motion to accept the \$1,900 bid from Dustin Burton to install a grinder pit station at the Dollar General Store, adding Burton's proof of insurance and bond was first provided, Carol Youngblood second the motion. Philip Fowler voted, "nay;" motion passed.


Philip Fowler made a motion to approve the June 2019 bank reconciliation, Carol Youngblood second the motion, all were in favor.

Philip Fowler moved to adjourn the Town Council Meeting, Loren Moore second the motion, all were in favor.
