

Monrovia Town Council Meeting

October 28, 2019

7:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Town Council President Robert Marley, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer by Philip Fowler.

Eddie Menzel met with Jessica Hartman, Town Engineer, and Brian Monech, Faukenberg's Engineer. Monech is to put a plan together to give to Jessica, for Faulkenberg's pond on the west side to hold water and on the east side to release water.

President Marley stated that the town's current waste water runs about half capacity. But we might want to start thinking about increasing the size over the next three years.
