

Monrovia Town Council Meeting

May 13, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Town Council President Robert Marley, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Jason Inglert, Mac McCloud, John Faulkenberg and Bill Fite were among several citizens and guests in attendance.

Marley said the first issue he would like to address was the sewer hookup on Baltimore Road for the proposed building of a new home. He stated no one he had spoken with about paying for the lateral for the new home would do so. He added no one recommended cutting the road, stating it could result in potential problems due to the two (2) sewer lines. Marley said the grinder pump is the best solution.

Jason Inglert asked if the homeowners would be responsible for maintaining the grinder pump, Marley said, yes. Inglert stated he feels the grinder pump is not a good idea, adding cutting the road is the right way.

Fowler said he wants to see the plans from Inglert on how they want to cut the road.

After much discussion, Marley said he will get with Triad and meet back at our next town council meeting.

Bill Fite, Mac McCloud and John Faulkenberg were present to discuss the storm drainage on Baltimore Road by their residences. There was extensive discussion and reviewing of the pictures showing all the flooding on Baltimore Road. Faulkenberg then presented his pictures showing he was in complete compliant according to the town's engineer; at the time of his housing development project.

Marley said there was no other business tonight, however he wanted to mention they were dewatering at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, if anyone on the Council was interested in seeing it.


Minutes
