The meeting was called to order by Town Council President Robert Marley, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Minutes

Philip Fowler made a motion to approve the May 13, 2019 Town Council Minutes as presented, Loren Moore second the motion, all were in favor; motion passed.

Baltimore Road Sewer Connection

Marley said he first wanted to discuss the Baltimore sewer issue. He said Jonathan Moen with Triad Engineering could not be present for tonight's meeting. However, Marley explained after meeting and discussing this issue with Triad, he now felt more comfortable with Inglert cutting the road to connect the Newlin's into the town's gravity sewer line. Marley added his main concern was safety.

Jason Inglert handed out paperwork outlining the scope of work for the Baltimore Road sewer connection. After detailing his proposed plans to the council members, Marley asked if anyone would like to make a motion on this subject matter.

Carol Youngblood made a motion to accept Inglert's proposal for cutting Baltimore Road to hook Jeff and Joni Newlin's property into the town's sewer system with the condition of his liability insurance and bond is in place, Bonnie Silsby-Inman second the motion, all were in favor; motion passed.
