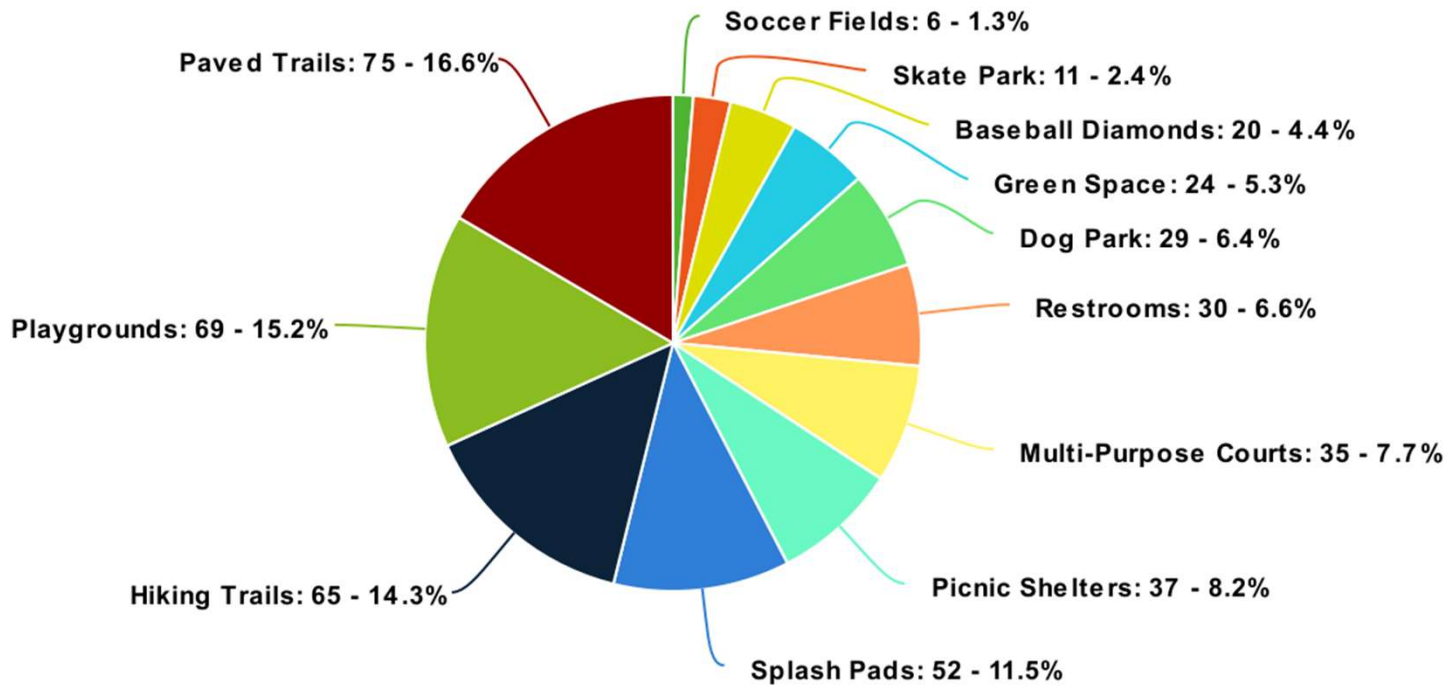
# Survey Overview

- 85.5% of Respondents are citizens of Monrovia.



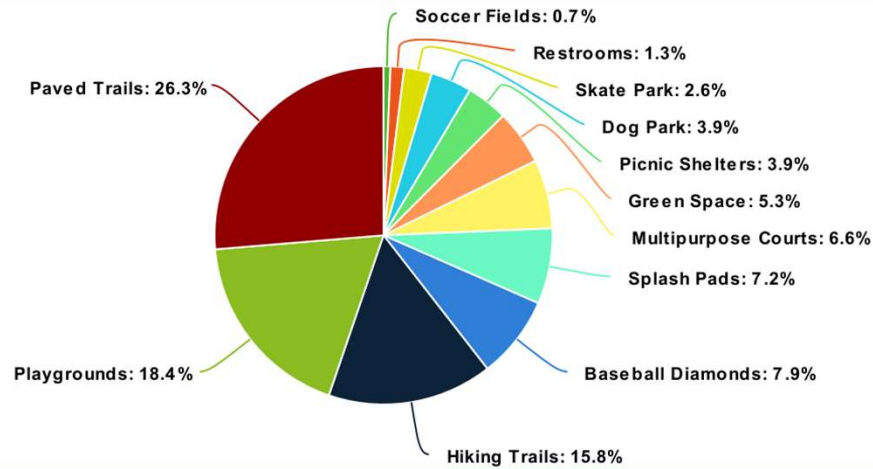
## Amenities Overall

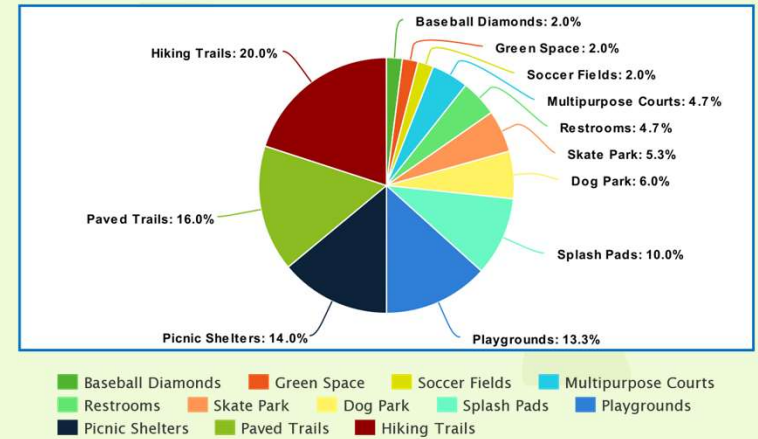

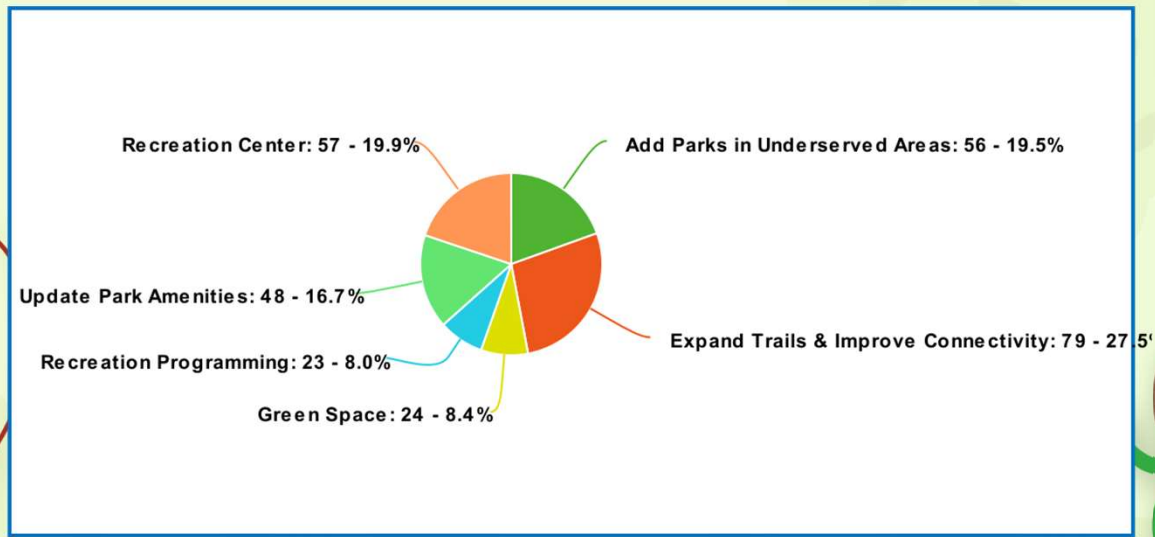

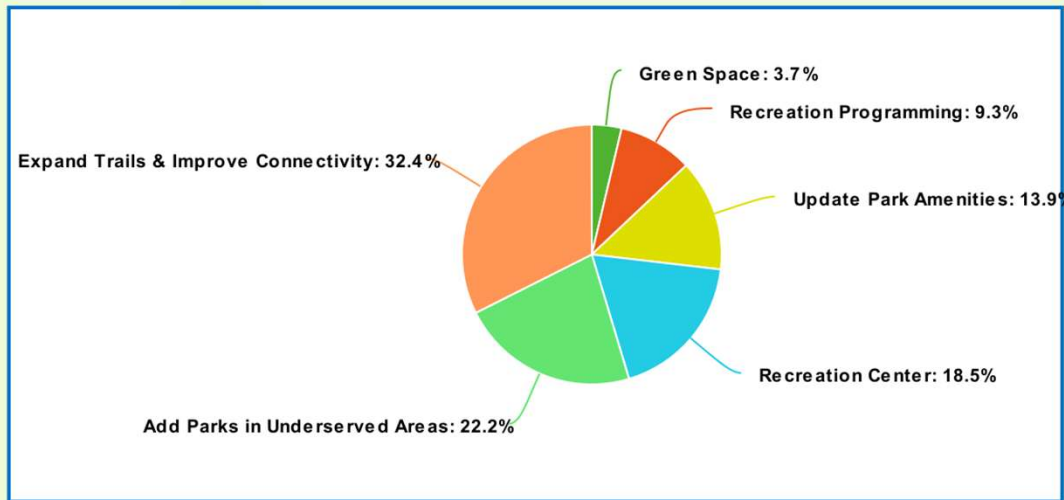

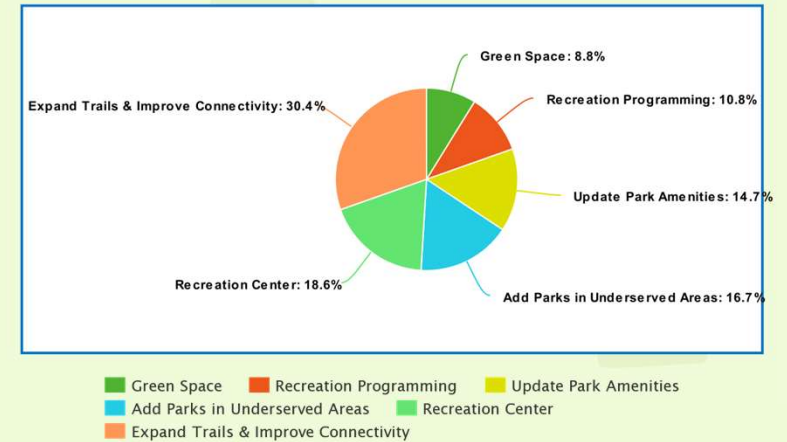


# Top 3 Priorities For Park & Recreation Board

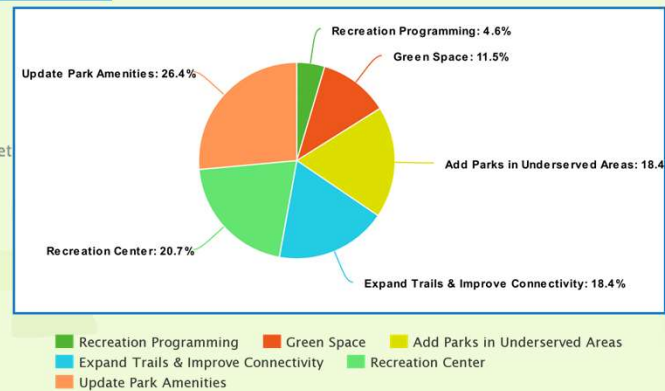


Second Most Important

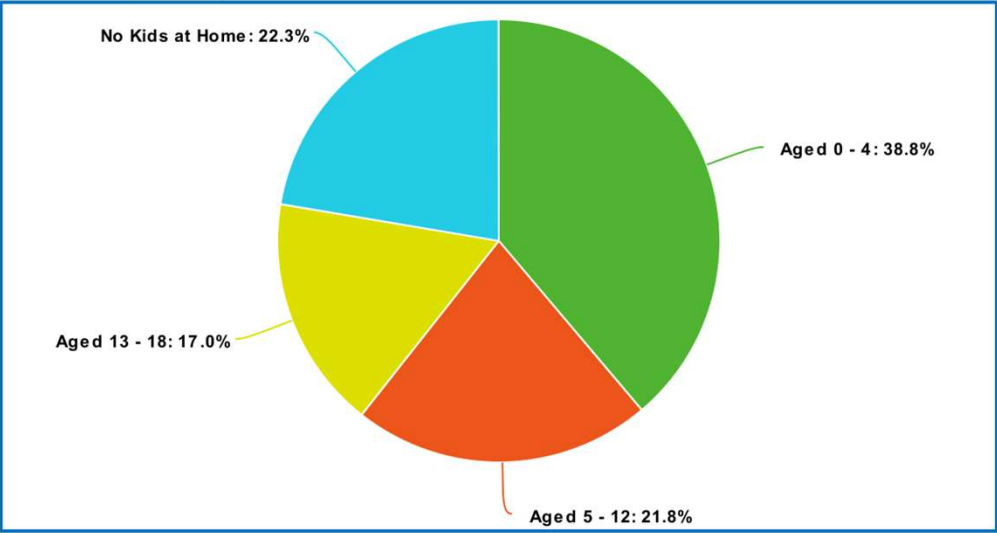

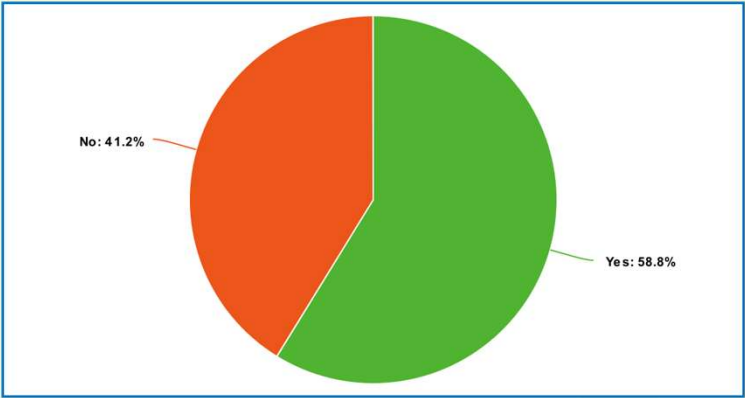

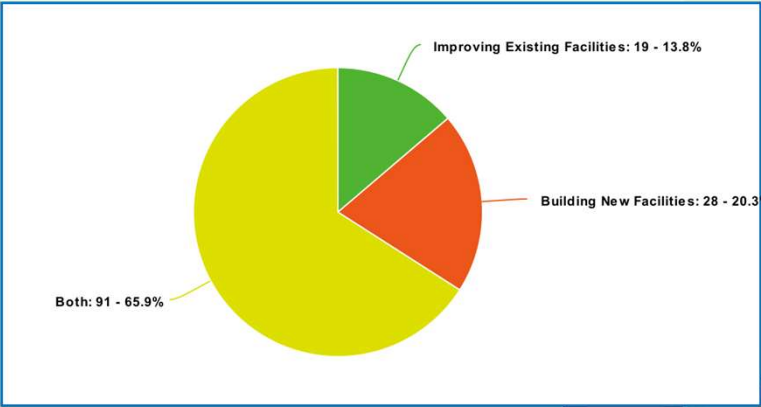
Children Statistics
