

ORDINANCE 2023- 04

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE TOWN OF MONROVIA, INDIANA

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the Town of Monrovia's 2023 Public Safety annual budget.

WHEREAS, to maintain continuity of its services and to ensure public safety services remain available and uninterrupted by this shortfall, additional funds need to be appropriated from the Public Safety Fund (#2240) for said purpose.




