TOWNSHIPS

Indiana Statue establishes that each county has a varying number of townships. The elected trustee has an elected board of three to work with and oversee the duties assigned to the trustees. The duties are primarily:

- Providing for poor relief and burial of the indigent
- · Maintaining cemeteries and burial grounds
- Resolving fence disputes
- Controlling weeds and underbrush
- Managing the township budget and financial records
- · Preparing an annual financial report
