RE: 2024-2 CCMG CALL FOR PROJECTS

The CCMG 2024-2 Call for Projects opens on 7/1/24 and closes on 7/31/24.

Attached are the emails between the Town Manager and Triad Associates regarding the feasibility of having the Town-wide Road Maintenance & Improvement Plan and Sidewalk Improvement Plan that they are working on completed in time for submission (if agreed to by the Council).

Also attached is the Pavement Asset Management Plan prepared by Triad. It scores various roads, with roads scored <7 as candidates for repair/work. Baltimore Road, W Union Church Rd, Washington, Walnut & Water Street among others have lower scores.

CCMG funding is a 75% / 25% matching grant. We presently have the following applicable fund balances from which our 25% matching funds can be appropriated:

Danny,

The Pavement Asset Management Plan (PAMP) is done, I can send you the spreadsheet with the street ratings that are typically used to select streets for CCMG projects. We are in the process of combining the ratings spreadsheet with pictures we took so you have a visual reference of all roads that are included in the PAMP.

Sidewalk improvements are permitted in the CCMG projects provided there is sufficient space between the edge of pavement and the property line (R/W), and the State requires the pavement improvements on the street to be a minimum of 1-1/2" HMA overlay. The recommended sidewalk width is 5' but it can go as narrow as 3' if necessary.

Most communities that I work with on CCMG projects select roads with mid-range scores of 4-6 to do pavement patching and overlay projects. This provides the biggest bang for the community's money. Lower scores typically require more extensive patching which costs more and reduces the road mileage that the community can do.

Typically, most communities know what they have available to spend on CCMG projects and what streets they want paved. Adding sidewalk affects the final cost but we can develop estimates if the town can provide me with an idea of what roads you are looking to pave and what roads you would like to see sidewalks added or repaired.

The town will need to allocate funds for FY 25. Applications are due no later than July 31, 2024, the State typically announces awards in October. The date of award starts the clock for municipalities to be under contract with a contractor. The State requires awarded communities to be under contract with a contractor within 4 months of the award announcement. If you fail to meet that deadline, the State rescinds the award. With October announcements, you would need to bid and award the project in late February or early March of 2025.

I'm attaching the PAMP spreadsheet for your review; I have highlighted streets with scores under 7 for your consideration; I am also available to meet with the Town Council to discuss the potential CCMG project. The earlier the Town decides on a project, the earlier the application can be submitted. Early submitted CCMG applications are reviewed by INDOT personnel for completeness, and they will notify you if they see something missing or incorrect allowing you time to correct the application. The closer an application submission is to the deadline, the less likely that INDOT will have time to review the applications for completeness. Hope this helps.

Jonathan & Lou,

The 2024-2 Community Crossings Grant Program Call for Projects opens on July 1st and will close on July 31st.

Would it be possible to have the Town-wide road & street pavement improvement plan that you/Triad are working on completed (including the detailed cost estimate) in time to meet the submission window if the Council so decides? The 75/25 match (as we learned in 2022) is terrific. Could the sidewalk improvement plan be a component as well?

Also, if we proceed, would the work & costs occur in 2025, requiring us to budget for it during this summer/falls budget preparations for the 2025 Town budget.
